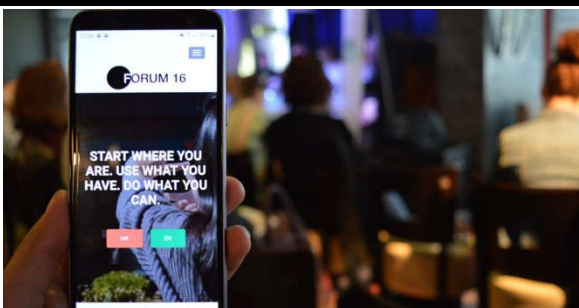
Participation at Youth Exchange in Estonia
